TCRF's Magnolia Council Honors Two At Luncheon

Nearly 650 people attended the Tower Cancer Research Foundation's Magnolia Council's Spirit of Hope Luncheon at The Beverly Wilshire. The event raised almost \$500,000 for research grants and patient support programs.

The afternoon honored board member Shelley Warsavsky, who served as president (2009-2013) and who has been instrumental in the development and growth of the group since its founding.

Also recognized was Dr. Edward H. Phillips, professor of surgery, vice chairman of the department of surgery, director of the division of general surgery, and founding director and co-director of the Saul and Joyce Brandman Breast Cancer Center at Cedars-Sinai Medical Center. He is considered a leading practitioner, clinical researcher and pioneering authority on laparoscopic and breast surgery.
