CANCER FREE GENERATION — Tower Cancer Research Foundation's Cancer Free Generation, the young leadership division of Tower, held its most successful Celebrity Poker Tournament fundraiser to date this past Saturday at the Sofitel Hotel at Beverly Hills. The event, which honored breast cancer survivor and advocate Brittney Cade Pritchard and her husband, Green Day's Mike Dirnt raised over \$200,000 for cancer research.
